
T2 Licence

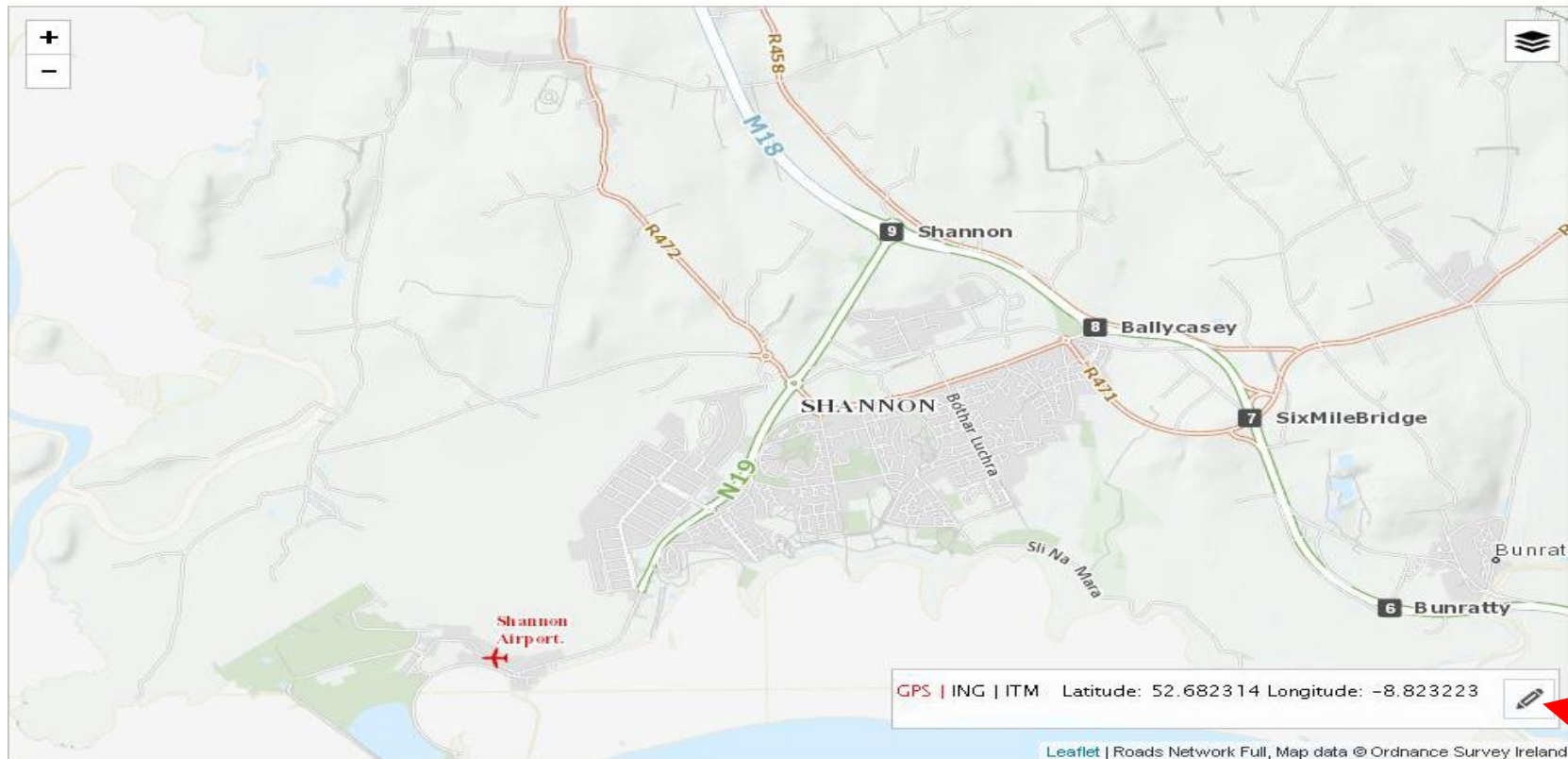
